



4 Day Expedition Baie Éternité - Baie Ste Catherine

<p>First day</p> <p>8H We meet at our store in Baie Ste Catherine : you meet the guide, briefing of the trip, distribution of wetsuits and life jackets. We park the cars and transfer luggage into our bus. 9H Departure by bus and trailer towards Baie Éternité (bus transportation permit from the CTO) 10H30 Arrival at Baie Éternité, security briefing, unloading of kayaks and transfer of luggage into them. 12 H Lunch, launching of the boats, getting familiar with the handling of your kayak on the water. 17H30 Arrival at Anse de Tabatiere, camp setup, diner preparation. 18H30 outdoor dining and free time.</p>	<p>Day 3 and 4:</p> <p>8H Breakfast 9H Take off and travel to next campsite. The biggest part of paddling time is done after high tide and depending on the wind condition. Second night: After Anse St-Jean, lunch at Anse a Tidé. Passage towards Île St-Louis and camping at Anse au Cheval. Diner and free time. Third day: Cruzing along the Baie Ste Marguerite, a protected Beluga sanctuary, lunch at anse St Etienne, Camping at Anse à David</p>	<p>Last day :</p> <p>8H Breakfast 9H Launching of kayaks towards Cap de la Boule and the Chute du Caribou. Lunch at Cap Blanc or at pointe a la Croix. Observation of the Minky whale at the mouth of the Fjord and in the Baie Ste Catherine 15h end of the expedition and getting back to your car. Farewell to the guide.</p> <p>4h of kayaking per day minimum (It is possible that the guide decides to modify the schedule and trajectory depending on weather conditions.)</p>
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Level of strain: Moderate Level of difficulty: easy Ratio of 1 guide/8 in group, min 4 maxi 8 Expedition trajectory is in backcountry territory, away from medical assistance.

Security : Azimut Aventure owns a boat for emergencies (230 HP) that can carry up to 12 passengers. This gives a great level of security to the expeditions without taking away from the backcountry experience. Our guides, FCKQ Level III certified and with first aid certification for backcountry territory, are knowledgeable and have a lot of experience on the Fjord. They are trained for cold water rescue.
 Azimut Aventure reserves the right to modify the trajectory for security reasons and weather conditions.

Rescue by boat in the event an emergency. 	<p>Cost :</p> <p>Basic package is 496\$ + taxes (you must be independent at the camping site, food and tent wise). Deluxe package is 720\$ +taxes (the guide takes care of every thing : the tent and the meals are taken care of and included)</p> <p>Group prices available during off season including transportation by bus from the major cities of the province of Quebec.</p>
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Plan to bring: warm clothes for around camp, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, insect repellent, sleeping bag, toiletry, etc. A more extensive list will be sent to you depending on the package you choose.

Food for the deluxe package :

Breakfast: crêpe, muffins, yogurt, fresh fruit, espresso, tea, jam, maple syrup, cheese etc.
 Lunch : sandwiches, pita, salads, taboulé, raw vegetables, desert, fresh fruit pastries.
 Diner: cream of vegetable, spaghetti bolognaise, cheese fondue, beef and vegetables, etc, cake.
